2005 Apremont

“...Savoie, is the source of one of my favorite cheap and interesting white wines in the world: the Apremont of Pierre Boniface, a remarkably pure, crystalline white that is a vinous reflection of its Alpine home. It's made from the ancient Jacquere grape which is grown only in the Savoie region (Apremont is a cru designation - even in tiny Savoie there are special cru wines: it is France after all). But even the crus in Savoie are affordably priced; the Boniface is about \$12 a bottle.”
