Tinto 2005

"The 2005 Tinto is grapy, and initially shows a bitter finish. It is very young and needs some time to settle down. There are light tannins around the edges. With air, the bitterness faded, and the fruit became more pleasing, in fact, rather tasty. The wine displays a certain lively, fruit-forward demeanor that it did not have initially. This is a relatively simple wine, but a very pleasant one, that gains charm, flavor and a little weight with additional aeration. Admittedly, it is not as impressive as the fancy bottle. Although it will hold, this is a good wine to drink – once it settles down – when it is fresh and exuberant. It should be approachable sometime in mid-2007, probably better at the end of the year. Drink 2007-2011."
