



## ALTO AGRELO CHARDONNAY/TORRONTES 2007

### ORIGIN

Mendoza (Argentina).

### COMPOSITION

90% Chardonnay, 10% Torrontes.

### VITICULTURE

Vineyards are situated in Mendoza, at the foot of the Andes at nearly 2,500 ft above sea level. It is a semi-arid climate, with sandy/alluvial soils under a stony surface. Vines are drip irrigated.

### VINIFICATION

Fermented at controlled temperatures in stainless steel tanks. The wine underwent malolactic fermentation. Unoaked.

### ANALYSIS

12.8% alc/vol

### TASTING NOTES

Plenty of tropical fruit aromas on the nose, with the Torrontes imparting a touch of floral/exotic fruit character. Big, round and rich on the palate, it is well-balanced, with excellent acidity and clean finish.

### SERVE WITH

Enjoy on its own, with hearty salads, or with simply prepared chicken or fish dishes.
