#### ORIGIN

Lujan de Cuyo, Mendoza (Argentina). South and west of Mendoza is Lujan de Cuyo, one of the finest Appellations of Argentina. This is known as the 'First Zone', where Argentina's wine industry was born. Some of the oldest Malbec vineyards here produce wines of the highest quality and reputation.

100% Malbec.

3.6 tons/acre

#### VINIFICATION

Macerated 15 days on the skins. Alcoholic fermentation lasted 7 days. Unoaked. Unfiltered and unfined.

#### ANALYSIS

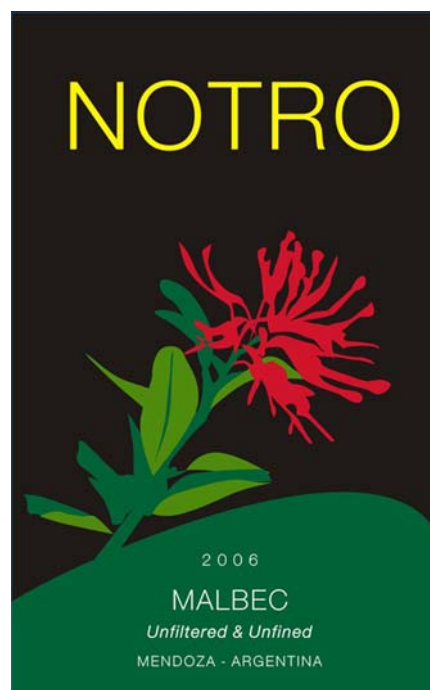

Bursts with aromas of plums, blackberries and violets. It is medium-bodied on the palate, with soft tannins and vibrant, dark fruit flavors.
