ORIGIN

Minervois A.O.C.

VINEYARDS

151 acres; 44 Carignan, 36 Merlot, 30 Syrah, 28 Grenache, 8 Cabernet Sauvignon, 5 Cinsault.

COMPOSITION

40% Syrah
40% Cinsault
20% Grenache

VITICULTURE

The Cinsault vines average 55 years in age, the Grenache 35, and Syrah 20+ years.

YIELDS

2 2/3 tons/acre.

VINIFICATION

100% tank-bled wine, fermented at controlled temperatures.

ANALYSIS

12% alc/vol.

TASTING NOTES

Pale pink peach and salmon color. Fresh aromas of roses and red cherries with a hint of grapefruit. Nicely dry on the palate with good body and a rich, silky texture. The finish is long, piquant, with a tiny appetizing hint of bitterness.

SERVE WITH

This has enough weight to match with chicken, sausage or ham.
